Collection Information**

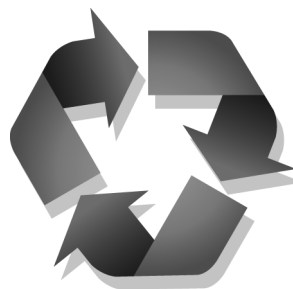
Bring waste to the collection site on the scheduled day during hours of operation.

**DO NOT LEAVE ITEMS AT THE SITE DURING OFF HOURS.**

- ◆ Do not mix wastes.
- ◆ If a container is unmarked or not the original container, let a collection crew person know what is in the container, if possible.
- ◆ All waste must be brought to the collection site at the Petersburg Solid Waste Baler Facility, 1301 Reservoir Road.
- ◆ Waste Oil: Please label the container.
- ◆ Paint: Do not mix oils and latex.
- ◆ Avoid bringing children or pets to the collection event.

**Items Not Accepted**

- ◆ Food wastes
- ◆ Household trash or scrap metal.  
*(Cardboard boxes and plastic bags used to transport the waste will be accepted for disposal.)*
- ◆ Explosives such as blasting caps and gunpowder
- ◆ Reactives such as sodium metal or radioactive wastes
- ◆ Infectious wastes
- ◆ Large lithium and cadmium batteries
- ◆ Asbestos Containing Material
