This project generally consists of erosion and sediment control, constructing a temporary work pad, temporarily extending the dam bypass pipe through the work pad, removing approximately 4 inches of concrete from the face of the spillway, placing concrete reinforcing and concrete to create a new dam face as well as other miscellaneous and incidental work.
