OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT SOUTH FORK SAGINAW CREEK RESTORATION PROJECT

The Petersburg Ranger District is proposing to implement instream and riparian restoration on approximately 0.6 miles of South Fork Saginaw Creek and up to 0.4 miles of Shorty Creek, a medium-sized tributary to Rowan Creek on Kuiu Island. These streams support populations of pink salmon (Oncorhynchus gorbuscha), chum salmon (O. keta), coho salmon (O. kitsuch), steelhead (O. mykiss), coastal cutthroat trout (O. clarki clarki), and Dolly Varden char (Salvolinus malma). The project area includes the instream and floodplain restoration areas, as well as the wood collection and access areas for both streams. The wood necessary to complete this project includes whole trees with rootwads still attached, cut logs, and cull wood.

How to Comment and Timeframe

Individuals and organizations wishing to be eligible to object must meet the information requirements of 36 CFR 218 Subparts A and B.

It is the responsibility of persons providing comments to submit them by the close of the comment period. Only those who submit timely and specific written comments regarding the proposed project during a public comment period established by the responsible official are eligible to file an objection under §218.

Written, facsimile, hand-delivered, and electronic comments concerning this action will be accepted for 30 calendar days following the publication of this notice in the Petersburg Pilot. The publication date in the newspaper of record is the exclusive means for calculating the comment period for this analysis. Those wishing to comment should not rely upon dates or timeframe information provided by any other source. The regulations prohibit extending the length of the comment period.
