Federal legislation states that, as a minimum, each LEPC shall include representatives from the following groups: elected officials, law enforcement, civil defense, firefighting, first aid, health, local environmental, hospital, transportation personnel, broadcast and print media, community groups, and owners/operators of facilities subject to regulation by SARA Title III.

**The Petersburg LEPC currently has vacancies for the following positions: Transportation and Public at Large.**

Detailed information regarding the composition, duties, and responsibilities of an LEPC can be found in Chapter 8 of the book *SARA Title III, Intent and Implementation of Hazardous Materials Regulations*. Alaska Statute 26.23.071 establishes the Alaska SERC and LEPCs, and specifies their duties.
