NO U-TURNS

Effective 06/01/2021 there will be no u-turns allowed at the north end of Main Street, until further notice. It is anticipated that this change will be temporary and will not continue after the end of canning season. There will also be an additional pedestrian crosswalk in place across North Nordic, partway up PFI Hill. These changes are being made to ensure the safety of workers waiting to gain entry into the OBI cannery through one of the checkpoints set up outside. We appreciate the efforts OBI Seafoods is making to provide Covid screening in order to ensure the safety of their workers and the public and are dedicated to doing our part to support these efforts.

Motorists will need to exercise caution when navigating in this area due to the change in traffic patterns and the presence of more pedestrians than normal on the road shoulders and in the crosswalk areas. If a motorist needs to turn around going north, continue northward to 1st Street at the top of PFI Hill, then use Dolphin to get back to Main Street. Or alternatively, go up Excel and then back down Dolphin. No u-turns will be allowed on Main Street as this would result in unsafe conditions.
