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PETERSBURG BOROUGH SCOW BAY PUMP STATION 1 UPGRADE INVITATION TO BID

Notice is hereby given that the Petersburg Borough will receive sealed bids for the Scow Bay Pump Station 1 Upgrade Project. This Project generally consists of the installation and integration of a new sewer pump station into an existing sanitary sewer system to include; installation of pipe, fittings, concrete wet well, valve vault, and manhole, electrical panels, associated mechanical and electrical systems, supervisory control and data acquisition system interface, grading and drainage, concrete slab on grade, installation of owner supplied pumps and discharge elbows, coordination with local utilities, and other miscellaneous and incidental work.

The estimated construction cost is between \$350,000 and \$450,000. All Work must be substantially complete by November 15, 2019.

Sealed bids will be received by the Petersburg Borough, Post Office Box 329, Petersburg, Alaska 99833, located in the Municipal Building, No. 12 South Nordic Drive, Petersburg, Alaska 99833 until 2:00 p.m. prevailing time on Tuesday, July 2, 2019 at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud in the Borough Assembly Chambers.

A non-refundable fee of \$50.00 made payable to the Petersburg Borough is required for each set of contract documents. Additional charges will be required for special handling or delivery of the documents by means other than first class mail.
