INVITATION TO BID

Notice is hereby given that the Petersburg Indian Association will receive sealed bids for the 12TH, HOWKAN, 13TH STREET SIDEWALK PROJECT. The project generally consist of the construction for sidewalks and storm water sewers along 12th Street, Howkan Street and 13th Street in Petersburg, Alaska. The project will be in three parts: base bid, additive item #1 & additive item #2. The bid will be awarded with base bid alone or base bid with a combination of additive bid items, either item or both. Base bid is approximately 1040 linear feet of sidewalk, with approximately 710 linear feet of storm water sewer. Additive bid item #1 is approximately 555 linear feet of sidewalk, with approximately 540 linear feet of storm water sewer. Additive bid item #2 is approximately 330 linear feet of sidewalk, with approximately 200 linear feet of storm water sewer. The estimated construction cost for the base bid is between \$400,000 & \$500,000. All Work must be completed by October 15, 2020.

Authorizing Long-term Indebtedness Through Loans from the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation, in a Principal Amount not to Exceed Eight Million Dollars (\$8,000,000), for the Purpose of Permitting, Designing and Constructing Water and Wastewater Utility Capital Projects

Shall the Petersburg Borough be authorized to incur long-term indebtedness, in a principal amount not to exceed Eight Million dollars (\$8,000,000) for the purpose of permitting, designing and constructing capital projects of the water and wastewater enterprises? The indebtedness would be a revenue obligation of the water and wastewater enterprises only and would be in the form of loans from the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC), with a term not to exceed 20 years, and with an annual interest rate of approximately 1.5%, or as otherwise established under the ADEC Municipal Loan Program. Any authorization approved hereunder by the voters shall expire on December 31, 2024 as to any indebtedness not incurred on or before that date.
