Notice is hereby given that the Petersburg Borough will receive sealed bids for the New Dock Project Adjacent To Harbor Office. The project consists of a Base Bid and one Bid Alternate. The Base Bid work generally consists of the demolition of the existing timber dock. Construction of a new dock using recycled construction materials furnished by Petersburg Borough & new material furnished by the contractor. The Bid Alternate consists of splicing additional pipe pile onto pipe pile listed in the Base Bid. The Bid Alternate item may be awarded at any time during the contract period on an as needed basis.

The estimated construction cost for the base bid is between \$200,000 & \$300,000. All Work must be completed by May 1, 2019.
