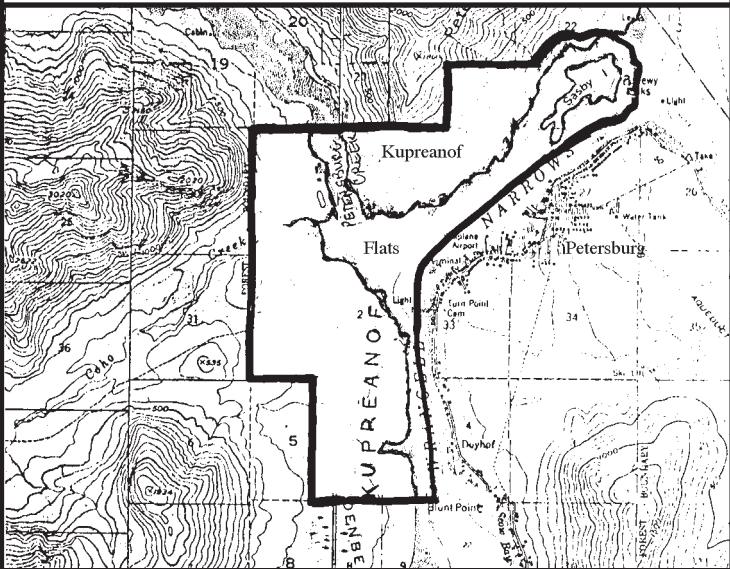

Project Scope of Work

The Petersburg Borough is seeking bids to complete the Blind Slough Hydroelectric Project Construction Contract. This contract is generally comprised of:

- Demolition and construction activities to accomplish the complete replacement and refurbishment of 1950's era equipment with owner-supplied generating equipment and switchgear
- Replacement and realignment of a portion of the lower penstock
- Piping modifications for the Crystal Lake Hatchery emergency water supply
- Other changes and modifications detailed in the plans and specifications
