### The following seats will be up for election:

**Council Member:** (3) – Two Year Terms  
**Council Chair (President):** (1) – One Year Term  
**JOM Parent Committee:** (3) – Two Year Terms  
**SEARHC Representative:** (1) – Three Year Term

Declarations of Candidacy must be received by December 27th, 2021 at 3:00pm.

Any eligible Tribal Members wishing to run as a write-in candidate must send a Letter of Intent by 3:00pm on December 30th.

## Christmas Tree CUTTING

You do not need a permit to cut a Christmas tree on the Petersburg Ranger District for personal use. Personal use Christmas trees cannot be sold.

There are no regulations on what tree species to cut or size to cut.

### However, please follow these guidelines:

- ⚠ Do not top a larger tree,
- ⚠ Do not cut a tree and then discard it for another one you find more desirable, and
- ⚠ Cut trees as close to the ground as possible (below the lowest limb or 12 inches from the ground).
