All forms for local election must be filed with the Borough Clerk. Forms required for filing can be obtained from the Borough Clerk's Office or at the Borough's Website (forms will be available July 26, 2022): www.petersburgak.gov.

The first day to file for candidacy: Tuesday, July 26, 2022

The last day to file for candidacy: Tuesday, August 23, 2022 by 4:30 p.m.

Any qualified person wishing to have his or her name placed on the ballot as a candidate for local elective office must meet the qualifications for office and follow the instructions as listed below:

Filing Requirements for Mayor and Borough Assembly

Be a Borough resident for at least one year;

Be a registered voter of the Borough;

File with the Borough Clerk:

- 1) a Declaration of Candidacy form;
 - 2) a Petition for Candidacy form signed by at least twenty qualified voters of the Borough; and
 - 3) a Municipal Exemption Statement obtained from the Borough Clerk.
- (The Municipal Exemption Statement can be filed if the candidate does not expect to spend over \$5,000 on his or her campaign).

Mayor positions to be filled at the election: (1)

One – three year term

Assembly Member positions to be filled at the election: (2)

Two - three year terms

Filing Requirements for Borough School Board

Be a Borough resident for at least 30 days;

Be a registered voter of the Borough;

File with the Borough Clerk:

- 1) a Declaration of Candidacy form;
 - 2) a Petition for Candidacy form signed by at least twenty qualified voters of the Borough; and
 - 3) a Municipal Exemption Statement obtained from the Borough Clerk.
- (The Municipal Exemption Statement can be filed if the candidate does not expect to spend over \$5,000 on his or her campaign).

School Board Member positions to be filled at the election: (2)

Two - three year terms

Filing Requirements for Hospital Board

Be a Borough resident for at least one year;

Be a registered voter of the Borough;

File with the Borough Clerk:

- 1) a Declaration of Candidacy form;
 - 2) a Petition for Candidacy form signed by at least twenty qualified voters of the Borough; and
 - 3) a Municipal Exemption Statement obtained from the Borough Clerk.
- (The Municipal Exemption Statement can be filed if the candidate does not expect to spend over \$5,000 on his or her campaign).

Hospital Board Member positions to be filled at the election: (3)

Three - three year terms

Filing Requirements for Planning Commissioner

Be a Borough resident for at least one year;

Be a registered voter of the Borough;

File with the Borough Clerk:

- 1) a Declaration of Candidacy form; and
 - 2) a Municipal Exemption Statement obtained from the Borough Clerk.
- (The Municipal Exemption Statement can be filed if the candidate does not expect to spend over \$5,000 on his or her campaign).

Planning Commissioner positions to be filled at the election: (4)

Be a Borough resident for at least one year;

Be a registered voter of the Borough;

File with the Borough Clerk:

 - 2) a Municipal Exemption Statement obtained from the Borough Clerk.

Petersburg Municipal Power & Light is grateful for our customers' electrical conservation during SEAPA's annual hydroelectric shutdown and throughout the June utility billing period.

Our community's effort made a difference, and the kilowatt-hour usage was the lowest it has been in the last 3 years!

Diesel fuel prices were higher than we've experienced in past years, but conservation efforts, in addition to a shorter diesel run allowed by SEAPA's reduced maintenance shutdown, have helped to minimize the fuel adjustment.

The fuel adjustment rate has been calculated to be:

**\$.02763/kWh or 2.763 cents
per kilowatt-hour.**

This rate will be applied to customers' June kWh usage and will be added to July's utility bills. You will be able to check the adjustment charge by multiplying the fuel adjustment rate by the electrical usage at your home or business from your June utility bill.



Thank you for making a conscious effort to conserve power in June. Your cooperation has helped to lower the impact of the fuel adjustment for your household and/or business, and for all Petersburg Municipal Power and Light customers.
