And all they that heard it wondered at those things which were told them by the shepherds.



Christmas in Petersburg... 100 Years ago By Sue Paulsen

In 1920s Petersburg the streets were made of wood and the pioneers were made of iron. This imaginary encounter takes place on Main Street in 1922.

Cub Reporter for the Petersburg Herald, John Johnson, makes his way through the crowd and greets a local matron with pad and pencil poised.

John: Excuse me, madam, but have you time for an interview for the Christmas column in the Petersburg Herald?

Ragna: Why, yes, I do.In fact, I have been compiling a list of Petersburg Yuletide events which I plan to include in a letter to my niece back in Norway. Who are you, young man? Where are you from?

John: I am John Johnson, new reporter for the Petersburg Herald! The editor sent me to find out what is going on in the way of Christmas celebrations here.I am from Ballard.

Ragna: I am Ragna Severson. Welcome to Petersburg, Mr. Johnson. Even though we are a town with boardwalks for streets, it is the 1920s and we now have 879 residents and 97 documented vessels so Christmas celebrations will be very big.


Luke 1:38 NKJV Then Mary said, "Behold the maidservant of the Lord! Let it be to me according to your word." And the angel departed from her.

The origins of "O Holy Night" can be traced to a request made by a 19th century French priest. In the fall of 1847, that priest asked a French merchant named Placide Cappeau to write a Christmas poem. Cappeau's poem was eventually shared with French composer Adolphe Adam, who quickly set the poem to music. The song made its debut on Christmas Eve 1847 and has been a beloved holiday song ever since.




